



Report on Lecture by Akshay Kumar on Preparation for UGC NET/JRF and HP SET Exams

Date: 30th December 2023

Organized by: Ecoholics Gang (Economics Society)

On 30th 2023, the Ecoholics Gang, the Economics Society, organized an insightful lecture in Lecture Hall 3 featuring Akshay Kumar, an Assistant Professor of Economics, who spoke on how to prepare for the UGC NET/JRF and HP SET exams in Economics. The session aimed to guide students in their preparation for these prestigious competitive exams.

Key Highlights of the Lecture:

1. Overview of UGC NET/JRF and HP SET Exams:

Ahuja & Koutsoyiannis for Microeconomics, Richard Froyen for Macroeconomics, and Uma Kapila for Indian Economy, along with relevant journals and publications. He encouraged students to refer to previous years' question papers and mock tests to get a better understanding of the exam pattern. Economic survey and budget of Centre government and state government is also very important.

5. Importance of Current Affairs:

Kumar emphasized the need to stay updated with current economic issues and developments. He advised students to regularly read newspapers like 'The Hindu' and 'Economic Times' and to follow reports from institutions like the Reserve Bank of India, NITI Aayog, and the International Monetary Fund.

6. Tips for Success:

Akshay Kumar shared several tips for success in these exams, such as:

- Focus on conceptual understanding rather than rote learning.
- Solve PYQs, particularly for Paper 2.
- Take regular mock tests to assess progress.
- Develop time management skills during the exam.

7. Interactive Session:

The lecture concluded with an interactive Q&A session, where students raised their concerns about preparation strategies and challenges faced during studies. Akshay Kumar patiently addressed all queries, offering personalized advice and motivational insights to keep the students focused and determined.

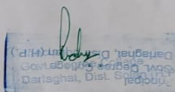

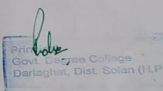
