## HOUSE EXAMINATION:

House examination for the session 2022-23 were held w.e.f. 11<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> December 2022. All the scripts were evaluated and the performance was duly communicated to the students before the winter vacation.

## INTER-COLLEGE PATICIPATION:

1. Four students represented the college in HPU Inter-college Youth Festival (Group-1) – CREATIVITY, held at RKMV, Shimla w.e.f. 19<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> September, 2022. They participated in Elocution, debate, poster-making, Collage and Cartooning.
2. Eight girls represented the college in HPU Inter-college Youth Festival (Group-IV) – THEATER, held at GGC, HAMIRPUR w.e.f. 24<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> November 2022. They presented a skit on the theme 'ROAD SAFETY'.

## CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

1. The teaching work commenced w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2022. However, the formal introduction and address by the Principal was held on 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. Every year this session aims at acclimatizing the students with the new environment.
2. On 12<sup>th</sup> August 2022 NSS unit organised "Har Ghar Tiranga Yatra" rally in the town. Activities like poster making and slogan writing were also organized. All the students including 40 NSS volunteers and faculty members participated in the rally with the tricolour i.e., the national flag painted on their cheeks and foreheads to commemorate the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of India's Independence.
3. **Mehndi competition** was organised on 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 to celebrate "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav."
4. In connection of the Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, **Independence Day** was celebrated in the college campus on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. All the staff members of the college and 50 NSS volunteers were present during the occasion.
5. An **electoral awareness camp** was organized by the NSS Unit on 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. Officials from the the Election Office, Arki appealed the students to sensitize the masses for voting and emphasized on the importance of voting.
6. On 5<sup>th</sup> September, **Teachers Day** was celebrated. An informal interactive session of teachers and students was organised where the students expressed their feelings towards their teachers. The innocence and sincerity of the expression was a mesmerising experience for the teachers.
7. On 9<sup>th</sup> September, **poster making** competition was held to celebrate the "Rashtriya Poshan Maah" which has been initiated by the Ministry of Women and Child Development.

8. On 14<sup>th</sup> September, **Hindi Divas** was celebrated by organising activities like Poetic symposium, debate, paper-reading, and slogan-writing.
9. On 16<sup>th</sup> September 2022 a **Slogan-writing** competition was organized on "Poshan Maah Abhiyaan".
10. On 23<sup>rd</sup> September, the **SVEEP** program for voters' education was held wherein Mr. Ajay Kumar, Assistant Professor of Political Science, and SVEEP NODAL OFFICERS highlighted the significance of voting and explained the fundamental contribution of voting in the democratic governance.
11. On 29<sup>th</sup> September, a **rally regarding awareness about nutrition and health** was organised during "Poshan Maah Abhiyaan". The rally culminated at Lord Shiva Temple, Syar where the temple committee and the people of Syar Panchayat distributed fruits and refreshment.
12. On 29<sup>th</sup> September, after the rally, an "**Enrolment cum Orientation session for NSS**" was organised where NSS programme Officer Prof. Ajay Kumar explained the motives and objectives of NSS. 52 students of B.A. II & III were also enrolled on the same day.
13. On 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022, Dr Vishav Jyoti, Assistant Professor of Sociology, delivered a lecture on the topic '*Importance of Nutrition for young girls*' in which she explained the significance of eating healthy foods.
14. On 31<sup>st</sup> October, **Unity Day** was celebrated to mark the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabh bhai Patel. A **Run for Unity Race** was organised along with Yoga and Broad jump competitions. The students took active part in these activities and expressed their solidarity with the spirit of the Unity Day.
15. On 15<sup>th</sup> November, **Career Counselling Cell** organised a counselling session for the students. Mr S Gulati, Director of Coaching Centre at Chandigarh, was invited to reflect on various career options in the present scenario. He focused on various career options and their desired skills. He also shared some basic and advanced techniques for cracking any competitive exam.
16. On 26<sup>th</sup> November, **National Constitution Day** was celebrated. A pledge of *commitment to the constitution* was taken by the students and staff. Mr Ajay Kumar, Assistant Professor of Political Science, explained various constitutional provisions. A quiz competition was also organised.
17. On 26<sup>th</sup> November 2022, **Road Safety Club** collaborated with Dainik Jagran and Darlaghat Police team, led by SHO Sh. Subhash Kumar to emphasize the importance of safety on the road. The resource person said that accidents can be avoided only by following road safety rules.
18. On 30<sup>th</sup> November, branch manager of HDFC Bank Darlaghat visited the college for a special awareness drive regarding online vigilance. He focused on safe banking practices. He distributed a booklet regarding prevention of banking frauds and urged the students to spread the information in the society.
19. On 1<sup>st</sup> December, **Red Ribbon Club** organised AIDS awareness campaign through posters, slogans, songs and skit. Red Ribbon badges were also pinned to staff and students. Dr. Vishav Jyoti sensitized the girls on menstruation, health and hygiene.
20. On 9<sup>th</sup> December 2022, **the road safety pledge** was taken in collaboration with Dainik Jagran. All the students of our college pledged to ensure compliance with traffic rules.
21. On 20<sup>th</sup> December Oath taking ceremony of the *College Student Central Association (CSCA)* was held. The CSCA was constituted on the merit basis.
22. On 22<sup>nd</sup> December **Himachal Sanskrit Academy** organised a "*Sanskritik Chatra vidvat sammelnam*" in our college. Students from GC Dhami, GC Arki, SKT College Panjgain, Govt. SKT College Fagli, and Shimla also participated in this conference. Eminent Sanskrit scholars and poets interacted with the students.
23. On 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> December, 2022 **CSCA function** was organised. Students showcased their talent in academic (elocution, debate, poetic-recitation, essay-writing, paper/ppt presentation) and co-curricular activities (mehandi, rangoli, songs – Pahari, light vocal, rap etc; dances– solo, nati, bhangra, sammi, Jhoomer, and pahadigiddha (paduaan) etc.

## CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES

### Demands

1. The college campus may be constructed at the earliest.
