Introduction

The Parents Feedback Survey was conducted to gather insights from parents regarding their satisfaction with the educational environment and processes at GDC Darlaghat. This report outlines the key findings, highlighting strengths and areas that contribute to the overall experience of students

Survey Findings

1. Admission Experience

- 92% of responders expressed satisfaction in feeling that getting admission for their ward in the college is a matter of pride.
- 92% were also satisfied with the transparency of the admission process.

2. Teacher-Student Relationship

- 97% of parents reported that their wards have established a good rapport with teachers

3. Discipline and Atmosphere

- 84% of respondents noted that the discipline within the college is commendable
- 89% feel that the atmosphere in the college is conducive to learning

4. Student Development

- 89% of parents observed a positive change in their ward's behaviour since joining the college.

5. Information Accessibility

- 97% of respondents believe that college information is accessible to all
- 97% are satisfied with the college website, noting it is very informative and regularly updated.

6. Curriculum and Assessment

- 89% of parents agree that the curriculum is well-designed and enhances the learning experience for students.
- 79% are satisfied with the periodic and comprehensive nature of evaluations and assessments.

7. Staff Cooperation and Progress

- 100% of respondents find the college staff to be cooperative.
- 100% noted that the changes introduced in the college in the recent years have been progressive.

Conclusion:

The Parents Feedback Survey indicates a very high level of satisfaction among parents with the college's admission process, teacher-student relationship, discipline, and overall learning environment. The strong positive responses regarding staff cooperation, accessibility of information, and the usefulness of the college website further underscore parents' trust in the institution.
