

Action Taken Report on Parents Feedback Survey Conducted by: IQAC, Govt. Degree College Darlaghat

Introduction

The Parents Feedback Survey was conducted to understand parents' views on the admission process, discipline, teaching-learning environment, curriculum, assessment practices and overall development of their wards. The analysis shows a very high level of satisfaction in most areas, along with indications for sustaining and further strengthening existing good practices.

Admission Process and Communication

- In view of the very high satisfaction regarding pride in admission and transparency of the process, the college has decided to continue the present admission procedure with clear display of eligibility criteria, merit lists and schedules on the notice board and website.
- The admission committee will ensure that all relevant information (courses, fee structure, documents required, contact details) remains easily available to parents and students through notices and timely updates on the college website.

Teacher-Student Relationship and Student Behaviour

- The positive feedback on teacher-student rapport and improvement in students' behaviour has been shared with faculty in staff meetings to encourage continuation of a supportive and respectful academic environment.
- Teachers have been requested to maintain regular interaction with students, address academic and personal issues sensitively, and to promptly communicate serious behavioural or academic concerns to parents, where necessary.

Discipline and Learning Atmosphere

- The discipline committee and college administration will maintain the existing code of conduct that has contributed to a safe and disciplined campus, while sensitising students periodically about punctuality, attendance and classroom behaviour.
- Co-curricular and extension activities (NSS, NCC, cultural and sports programmes) will continue to be organised in a way that supports a healthy and learning-conducive atmosphere appreciated by parents.

Information Accessibility and Website

- In response to parents' appreciation of the accessibility of information and the college website, the college will continue to update important notices, examination schedules, results-related information and event reports on the website regularly.

- Parents will be encouraged, during meetings or through notices, to refer to the website and official communication channels for authentic information about the college.

Curriculum and Assessment Practices


