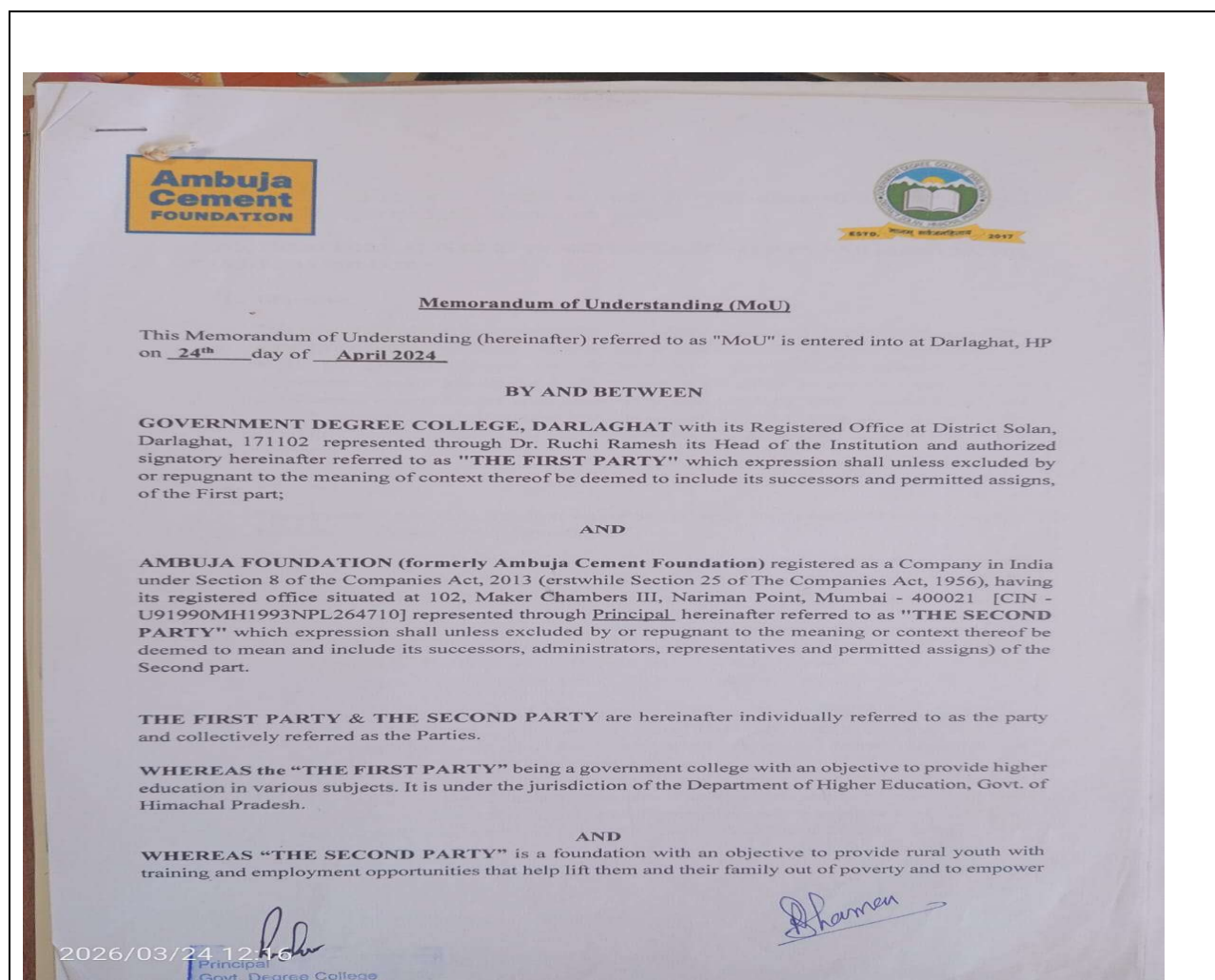




### Criteria 3.7

#### i. Laboratories with adequate equipment according to syllabi

Government Degree College Darlaghat has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Ambuja Cement Foundation for resource sharing, specifically aimed at providing Tally software training to the Commerce students of the institution.



“THE FIRST PARTY” has expressed its interest to “THE SECOND PARTY” to impart Training and skills for the Youth, students, and teachers.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Objective:

This subject agreement may be considered as a Memorandum of Understanding to pool the respective strengths, resources, expertise and goodwill of both the respective parties to the MoU. The primary objective of this proposal is to enable and enhance the skill development/upskill among the youth to impart the skills, workplace experience and certifications required to get good jobs to earn decent incomes and to sustain themselves. Broadly, the areas to be covered under the project are Skill development, vocational skills, IT related, Artificial Intelligence, etc. and any other courses as per the requirement of both Parties.

2. Purpose:

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for cooperation and collaboration between The Parties in the following areas:

I. **Training and Skill Development:** The First Party and The Second Party will collaborate on training programs to enhance the skills and employability of students. This will entail cooperation on broadly two aspects:

- a. Technical Partnership i.e. imparting training to students in vocational courses and other fields of increasing importance in employment industry, including but not limited to IT, Artificial Intelligence, Data Sciences and tally. Provisions for such training will be made after college hours for students of the First Party.
- b. Knowledge Partnership i.e. imparting training to students of both Parties in various life skills like effective communication, leadership, critical-thinking, problem-solving, decision making, time-management, resilience, empathy, general health and nutrition, financial literacy among others.

II. **Skill Enhancement of Faculty Members:** The First Party and The Second Party will collaborate on skill enhancement of faculty members with respect to newly emerging technologies, especially those relevant to teaching like use of AI in education.
