Student Satisfaction Survey Report

Introduction

The Student Satisfaction Survey aimed to gather feedback from students regarding various aspects of their educational experience at GDC Darlaghat. This report summarizes the findings from the survey, highlighting areas of strength and suggesting areas for improvement.

Survey Findings

1. Course Curriculum and Skill Enhancement

- 93.9% are satisfied with the timely completion of the syllabus by teachers.
- 97.9% express overall satisfaction with the assessment of teachers.

3. College Environment and Facilities

- 95.9% of respondents are satisfied with the standard of education and the general ambiance of the college.
- 89.8% are satisfied with the physical infrastructure of the college library.
- . 98% are satisfied with the support and assistance provided by the college office staff.
- · 100% express satisfaction with the college website.
- . 89.7% are satisfied with classroom infrastructure.
- 89.7% are satisfied with drinking water facilities in the college
- . 95.9% are satisfied with the cleanliness and maintenance of college premises.

Suggestions for Improvement

While the overall satisfaction levels are high, the following areas have been identified for improvement based on student feedback:

- Enhance computer lab facilities.
- Improve cleanliness and maintenance across the college.
- Implement daily homework assignments.
- Provide additional classroom space.
- Upgrade facilities in the college canteen and campus grounds.
- Consider aesthetic improvements, such as painting walls.
- Ensure proper electricity supply throughout the college.
- Focus on improving the curriculum and subjects offered.
- Provide access to knowledgeable books and resources.
